Minutes of the CSSC Meeting

1st meeting of the Central Sanctioning & Steering Committee (CSSC) held in Room No.123-C, Nirman Bhawan, New Delhi under the Chairmanship of Secretary (Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs) to consider the proposals of the States/UTs for approval under the PM-eBus Sewa Scheme.

The 1st meeting of Central Sanctioning & Steering Committee (CSSC) was held on Thursday, the 19th October, 2023 in Conference Room No.123-C, Nirman Bhawan, New Delhi under the Chairmanship of Secretary (Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs) to consider the proposals of the States/UTs for approval under the PM-eBus Sewa Scheme. The list of participants is at Annexure –I.

2. Director (UT) welcomed all the Members of the CSSC and made a brief presentation on the proposals of 5 States & 2 UTs for 38 cities as recommended by P MEC (Project Monitoring and Evaluation Committee) in its meeting held on 19th October 2023. (Copy enclosed).

3. The Committee was briefly apprised of the salient features of the Scheme guidelines, Pre-qualification criteria and Challenge criteria for selection of the cities for sanctioning of eBuses. The proposal of the States & UTs was discussed through a presentation. After detailed deliberations, the Committee took the following decisions:

I. 5 States & 2 UTs demanded 3332 Buses for 38 Cities and the Committee sanctioned a total of 3162 Buses, as per State/UT wise details given below :-

- i. Chandigarh - 100 buses were demanded and the same number of buses was sanctioned. It was also noted that Chandigarh proposes to scrap 100 ICE Buses;
- ii. Gujarat - 475 buses for six Cities were demanded, including demand of 50 extra buses by Gandhinagar City. The committee sanctioned 425 buses only, as per the allocation under the scheme;
- iii. Haryana - 450 buses for seven Cities were demanded and the same number of Buses was sanctioned;

- iv. Jammu and Kashmir- 200 buses for two Cities were demanded and the same number of Buses was sanctioned subject to approval of PSM. The PSM approval is under process in Finance Department and the same is expected soon;
 - v. Maharashtra - 1340 buses for fourteen Cities were demanded, including demand of 50 extra buses by Thane. The committee sanctioned 1290 buses only, as per the allocation under the scheme;
 - vi. Odisha - 400 buses for four Cities were demanded, including demand of 50 extra buses by Brahmapur town. The committee sanctioned 350 buses only, as per the allocation under the scheme; and
 - vii. Punjab - 367 buses for four Cities were demanded including demand of 20 extra buses by Amritsar. The committee sanctioned 347 buses only, as per the allocation under the scheme.
- II. The issue of consideration of buses for which Letter of Agreement (LoA) already signed by Haryana Government against NEBP-I Tender was discussed by the Committee and it was decided that the matter may be discussed after receipt of formal proposal from State Government.
- III. The sanction of the buses is subject to the compliance of terms and conditions of the guidelines of the Scheme.

Minutes of the P MEC Meeting

1st meeting of the Project Monitoring and Evaluation Committee (PMEC) held in Room No. 125-C, Nirman Bhawan, New Delhi under the Chairmanship of Additional Secretary (D&UT), Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs for consideration of the proposals received from the States/UTs under the PM-eBus Sewa Scheme.

The 1st meeting of Project Monitoring and Evaluation Committee (PMEC) was held on 19-10-2023, Thursday in Room No. 125-C, Nirman Bhawan, New Delhi at 12:00 hours under the Chairmanship of Additional Secretary (D&UT, Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs) to consider the proposals of the 6 States and 3 UTs for 50 cities. The list of participants is at Annexure B.

2. Director (UT) welcomed all the Members of PMEC and made a brief presentation on the proposals.


3. The Committee was briefly apprised of the salient features of the Scheme guidelines, Pre-qualification criteria and Challenge criteria for selection of the cities for sanctioning of eBuses. The proposal of the States & UTs was discussed through a presentation. After detailed deliberations, the Committee recommended the following proposals to the CSSC (**Central Sanctioning & Steering Committee (CSSC)**):-

- I. The cities furnished the details in the required documents (Annexure 1, 3 & 4) and the demand of the cities was consolidated in the Annexure A enclosed. The proposals for 3,332 buses from 38 cities (5 States & 2 UTs) were considered by the Committee and recommended the following to the CSSC, MoHUA, as per details given below :-
 - i. **Chandigarh**- 100 buses were demanded and the same number of buses was recommended. It was also noted that Chandigarh proposes to scrap 100 ICE Buses.
 - ii. **Gujarat** - 475 buses for six Cities were demanded, including demand of 50 extra buses by Gandhinagar City and the committee recommended 425 buses.
 - iii. **Haryana** -450 buses for seven Cities were demanded and the same number of Buses was recommended by the committee.
 - iv. **Jammu and Kashmir**- 200 buses for two Cities were demanded and the same number of Buses was recommended subject to approval of approval of PSM. The PSM approval is under process in Finance Department and same is expected soon.



- v. **Maharashtra** - 1340 buses for fourteen Cities were demanded, including demand of 50 extra buses by Thane and the committee recommended 1290 buses.
 - vi. **Odisha** - 400 buses for four Cities were demanded, including demand of 50 extra buses by Brahmapur town and the committee recommended 350 buses.
 - vii. **Punjab** - 367 buses for four Cities were demanded including demand of 20 extra buses by Amritsar and the committee recommended 347 buses.
- II. The recommendation for sanction of the buses is subject to the compliance of terms and conditions of the guidelines of the Scheme.
