### **Minutes of the CSSC Meeting**

**2nd meeting of the Central Sanctioning & Steering Committee (CSSC) held through Video Conferencing (VC) under the Chairmanship of Secretary (Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs) to consider the proposals of the States/UTs for approval under the PM-eBus Sewa Scheme.**

The 2nd meeting of Central Sanctioning & Steering Committee (CSSC) was held in physical-virtual hybrid mode on 03-11-2023, Friday at 18:00 hours under the Chairmanship of Secretary (Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs) to consider the proposals of the States/UTs for approval under the PM-eBus Sewa Scheme. The list of participants is at Annexure –I.

2. Director (UT) welcomed all the Members of the CSSC and made a brief presentation on the proposals of 3 States & 1 UTs for 13 cities as recommended by PMEC (Project Monitoring and Evaluation Committee) in its meeting held on 3rd November 2023. (Copy enclosed).

3. The proposals of the States & UTs were discussed through a presentation. After detailed deliberations, the Committee took the following decisions:

I. 3 States & 1 UTs demanded 738 Buses for 13 Cities and the Committee sanctioned a total of 738 Buses, as per State/UT wise details given below :-

- i. Bihar – 400 buses for six cities were demanded and the same number of buses was sanctioned.
- ii. Maharashtra – 213 buses for five Cities were demanded and the same number of buses was sanctioned.
- iii. Meghalaya - 50 buses for one City were demanded and the same number of Buses was sanctioned.
- iv. Puducherry - 75 buses for one City were demanded and the same number of Buses was sanctioned, subject to submission of Undertakings for opening escrow account, Implementation of NCMC-based AFCS and Participation in CESL demand aggregation.

II. The proposal of Nashik City for 100 e-buses (12m standard size) was approved in 1<sup>st</sup> CSSC meeting. Nashik City, based on their revised assessment, has now requested for reduced number of buses i.e. 50 e-buses only. The revised proposal for 50 buses was accepted

III. The request of two cities of Gujarat (Bhavnagar & Jamnagar) for change of size of buses was discussed and the same was agreed to by the Committee.

**Minutes of 2<sup>nd</sup> Meeting of the P MEC**

**2<sup>nd</sup> meeting of the Project Monitoring and Evaluation Committee (PMEC) held in Room No. 125-C, Nirman Bhawan, New Delhi under the Chairmanship of Additional Secretary (D&UT), Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs for consideration of the proposals received from the States/UTs under the PM-eBus Sewa Scheme.**

2<sup>nd</sup> meeting of Project Monitoring and Evaluation Committee (PMEC) was held Friday, the 3<sup>rd</sup> November, 2023 in Room No.125-C, Nirman Bhawan, New Delhi at 1500 hours under the Chairmanship of Additional Secretary (D&UT), Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs to consider the proposals of the 3 States and 1 UT for 13 cities. The list of participants is at Annexure A.

2. Director (UT) welcomed all the Members of PMEC and made a brief presentation on the proposals.

3. The Committee was briefly apprised of the salient features of the Scheme guidelines, Pre-qualification criteria and Challenge criteria for selection of the cities for sanctioning of eBuses. The proposals of the States & UTs were discussed during the meeting. After detailed deliberations, the Committee recommended the following proposals to the CSSC (Central Sanctioning & Steering Committee), MoHUA :-

I. The cities furnished the details in the required documents (Annexure 1, 3 & 4) and the demand of the cities was consolidated in the Annexure B (enclosed). The proposals for 738 buses from 13 cities (3 States & 1 UT) were considered by the Committee and recommended the following to the CSSC, MoHUA, as per details given below:-

- a) Bihar – 400 buses for six Cities were demanded and the same number of buses was recommended.
- b) Maharashtra - 213 buses for five Cities were demanded and the same number of buses was recommended by the Committee.

- c) Meghalaya - 50 buses for one City were demanded and the same number of Buses was recommended by the Committee.
- d) Puducherry – 75 buses for one Cities were demanded and the same number of Buses was recommended. Undertakings for opening Escrow Account, implementation of ITMS and NCMC and participation in CESL aggregation are being sent separately.
- II. The recommendation for sanction of the buses is subject to the compliance of terms and conditions of the guidelines of the Scheme.
- III. The proposal of Nashik City for 100 ebuses (12m standard size) was approved in 1<sup>st</sup> CSSC meeting. Nashik City, based on their revised assessment, has now requested for reduced number of buses i.e. 50 e-buses only.
- IV. The request of two cities of Gujarat (Bhavnagar & Jamnagar) for change of size of buses were discussed and recommended by the P MEC.
