**Minutes of the 4<sup>th</sup> CSSC Meeting**

**4<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Central Sanctioning & Steering Committee (CSSC) under the Chairmanship of Secretary (Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs) to consider the proposals of cities under the PM-eBus Sewa Scheme.**

4<sup>th</sup> meeting of Central Sanctioning & Steering Committee (CSSC) was held at 5:00PM on 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2024, in Conference Room No. 123-C, Nirman Bhawan, New Delhi under the Chairmanship of Secretary (Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs) to consider the proposals received from the States/Cities under PM-eBus Sewa Scheme. The list of participants is attached (Annexure-I)

2. Director (UT) welcomed all the Members of the CSSC and made a brief presentation on the Guidelines of the Scheme and proposals of cities as recommended by Project Monitoring and Evaluation Committee (PMEC) in its meetings held on 23<sup>rd</sup> January and 1<sup>st</sup> February 2024. (Minutes of the meeting of PMECs enclosed).

3. Guidelines Part-II for Behind-the-meter power infrastructure as recommended by PMEC (Annexure 'II' of 3<sup>rd</sup> CSSC Minutes), were reviewed during the meeting. After detailed deliberations, the Committee took the following decisions:

- Most of the DISCOMs demand Security Deposit along with the estimate of deposit work of Behind-The-Meter Power Infrastructure (BTM) proposals which is to be borne by the consumer city. Therefore, to expedite the deposit work, it is necessary to release Security Deposit amount along with the sanctioned amount for BTM projects as advance to the city which will be adjusted from future fund flows of the city within 1 year from start of the bus operations.

4. The proposals of Maharashtra, Bihar, Haryana, and Gujarat for BTM Power projects were presented before CSSC (PPT enclosed). Based on the deliberations held during the meeting, the Committee sanctioned the proposals for 27 bus depots of 23 cities as detailed in Annexure-II.

- With the sanction of the above said BTM projects, total financial commitment stands at Rs.211.76 Crore.

5. With regard to the proposal of Bihar State for development of 2<sup>nd</sup> Depot (ISBT Bairiya, Patna), it was advised to explore the possibility of tapping the power line from nearby metro station and review the proposal accordingly.

6. The proposals of 3 cities for 200 buses were discussed and sanctioned, subject to submission of formal RFP (Request for proposal) and necessary undertakings, as per the details given in Table 1 below.

7. The Committee acknowledged that power estimates can vary from city-to-city depending on the number of buses planned for charging, distance of depot from the nearest DISCOM power source, variation in load limit on power supply prescribed by State supply code and different methods of laying of power cables as per local requirements of the city.

8. With regard to the proposal of Jalgaon city for BTM Project, the Committee advised to mention the cost of Power Transformer separately in the actual cost estimates of the HT line.

9. The Committee also discussed the proposal of Thane city for the development of Bus depot infrastructure. It was suggested to analyse the proposal along with the proposals of other cities. The Committee further suggested to verify the depot location so as to ascertain the adequacy of the available land in proportion to the number of buses to be accommodated.

### Minutes of 5<sup>th</sup> meeting of P MEC

**5<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Project Monitoring and Evaluation Committee (PMEC) held in Room No.125-C, Nirman Bhawan, New Delhi under the Chairmanship of Additional Secretary (Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs) to discuss the proposals and review behind-the-meter estimates of power infrastructure of the States/UTs for approval under the PM-eBus Sewa Scheme.**

The 5<sup>th</sup> meeting of Project Monitoring and Evaluation Committee (PMEC) was held on 23<sup>rd</sup> of January 2024, Tuesday in room No. 125-C, Nirman Bhawan, New Delhi at 1400 hours under the Chairmanship of Additional Secretary (Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs) to consider the e-bus proposals of 2 cities and consider Behind-the-Meter Power infrastructure proposals received from the 19 cities of four States for approval under PM-eBus Sewa Scheme. List of participants are attached in Annex – I.

2. P MEC discussed and reviewed the bus demand of 50 buses each from Sambalpur city (Odisha) and Chandrapur city (Maharashtra) with standard floor height (900mm). The demand of the cities are given below :-

- I. Sambalpur City (Odisha) :- 50 Midi Buses (9m)
- II. Chandrapur City (Maharashtra) :- 30 Midi Buses (9m) & 20 Mini Buses (7m)

3. The Committee recommends both the proposals to the CSSC (Central Sanctioning & Steering Committee) subject to the submission of necessary documents as per Para 3.1 (Pre-Qualification Criteria) of the Scheme guidelines.

4. The P MEC also deliberated on the proposals for development of behind-the-meter power infrastructure submitted by 19 cities from 4 States (Bihar, Maharashtra, Gujarat, and Haryana). P MEC made the following observation in respect of the proposal submitted by Rajkot City as under :-

4.1 The proposal of Rajkot city (Gujarat) for a load of 3900 kVA on the 11 kV powerline seems inadequate for 100 e-buses. P MEC advise the city to review the demand load and capacity of HT line and submit a revised proposal.



5 The Committee recommends the following 18 proposals of behind-the-meter power infrastructure from 18 cities in 4 States (Table 1) for consideration by Central Sanctioning & Steering Committee (CSSC).
