**Minutes of the 5<sup>th</sup> CSSC Meeting**

**5<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Central Sanctioning & Steering Committee (CSSC) under the Chairmanship of Secretary (Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs) to consider the proposals of cities under the PM-eBus Sewa Scheme.**

5<sup>th</sup> meeting of Central Sanctioning & Steering Committee (CSSC) was held at 3:15 PM on 20<sup>th</sup> February 2024, in Conference Room No. 123-C, Nirman Bhawan, New Delhi under the Chairmanship of Secretary (Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs) to review the Guidelines of the Scheme and also to consider the proposals received from the States/Cities under PM-eBus Sewa Scheme. The list of participants is at Annexure-I.

2. Director (UT) welcomed all the Members of the CSSC and made a brief presentation on the Guidelines of the Scheme and proposals of cities as recommended by Project Monitoring and Evaluation Committee (PMEC) in its meetings held on 12<sup>th</sup> February, 16<sup>th</sup> February and 20<sup>th</sup> February 2024. A copy each of Minutes of the meetings of PMECs is enclosed.
3. Guidelines for Bus Depot Civil Infrastructure proposals as recommended by PMEC, were reviewed during the meeting. After detailed deliberations, the Committee approved the Guidelines Part II for Development of Bus Depot Civil Infrastructure, as per Annexure-IV.
4. The proposals of 19 depots from 17 cities of 6 States/UT (Bihar, Chandigarh, Maharashtra, Meghalaya, Odisha and Jammu and Kashmir) for behind-the-meter (BTM) power infrastructure were presented before the Members of the Committee (PPT enclosed). Based on the deliberations held during the meeting, the Committee sanctioned the proposals of 14 depots of 13 cities as detailed in Annexure-II, with the following observations in respect of remaining proposals:
  - For Vasai Virar proposals for Yashwant Nagar and Nalasopara depot, it was decided to advise the city to explore the feasibility of accommodating all 100 buses in Yashwant Nagar depot since the area of the depot appears to be sufficient. The committee also advised to review the BTM Proposal accordingly.
  - Nashik city to revise the proposal with single source power supply.

- Proposals of Rourkela and Sambalpur cities need to be reviewed as the cost of high voltage line is not commensurate with the length of HT line, thus, the project cost seems to be on a higher side.

5. The proposals of 35 depots of 29 cities from 7 States/UT (Maharashtra, Odisha, Gujarat, Punjab, Meghalaya, Haryana and Jammu and Kashmir) for Bus Depot civil infrastructure were presented before the committee (PPT enclosed). Based on the deliberations held during the meeting, the Committee sanctioned the proposals of 15 depots from 12 cities as detailed in Annexure-III, with the following observations on the remaining proposals:

- The proposals to be examined keeping in mind the basic requirement of bus operations and safety. The cost of Administration Block needs to be rationalised.
- It was discussed not to provide CA for solar panels and systems at this stage, cities to first explore the feasibility of availing benefits from other Central or State schemes for solar power.
- Cities to identify the existing bus depots with availability of spare parking capacity for the buses to be deployed under PM-eBus Sewa scheme.
- For Faridabad, Sambalpur, and Rourkela, the cost of utilities needs to be reviewed.
- Cities to review the cost of civil structure for Srinagar, Akola, Ahmednagar, Kalyan Dombivli, Chhatrapati Sambhaji Nagar, Latur and Thane; which seems to be on higher side.
- City to review the cost of civil structure for Ichalkaranji as it appears to be under estimated.
- Solapur and Khapri Depot of Nagpur city, being brown field depots, they need to be reviewed with regard to all the basic infrastructure for bus operations and safety aspects as the same may be either existing or included in the city proposal.
- The proposal of Koradi Depot of Nagpur city need not be considered as the Depot is already operational.

6. With the sanction of above proposals, the financial commitment for BTM and Bus Depot Civil Infrastructure proposals stands at Rs.120.27 Crore and Rs. 68.35 Crores respectively.

7. Sanction of the above proposals is subject to the compliance of terms and conditions of the guidelines of the Scheme.


